TERMS AND CONDITIONS

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Water technology innovators – individuals, organizations (small, medium and big), academic institutions, research organizations, Labs, etc. from all over the world are invited to register and compete in the **InvenTrust Water Impact Challenges**. Participants can register either as individuals or form a team (maximum of 5 individuals). Participants retain ownership of their ideas. InvenTrust and its partners are only interested in helping to promote and reward innovative ideas.

Note:

The competition is void in those countries where prohibited or restricted by law. InvenTrust reserves the right to limit, or restrict upon notice, participation in the competition to any person or entity at any time for any reason.

REGISTRATION

To compete in the InvenTrust Water Impact Challenges, you must be a fully registered **Participant**. To complete your registration, you must:

1. Log on to www.inventrust.com and fill in the registration form (Registration is free of cost).
2. Create a **Participant (Individual/Team)** profile.
3. Visit the Open Challenges page and start participating.

Please note that every individual in a team must create profiles. Applications can be made through the profile of the team leader.

OPERATING COSTS

Participants will be responsible for funding their own solution development costs.

JUDGING CRITERIA

- Entries will be evaluated during the first-round based on the following criteria: **Learning, Business Application, Design and Technology**.
- Judges will also assess the background research and quality of explanation of the design.

COMPETITION OVERSIGHT

To ensure that the competition is fair, InvenTrust will appoint the following three panels:

ADVISORY BOARD





InvenTrust will recruit an Advisory Board composed of experts in the fields of water technology, business management and innovation. This board will remain in place throughout the competition to advise InvenTrust regarding the scientific and economic elements of the competition.

ETHICS REVIEW BOARD

InvenTrust will have an Ethics Review Board to review and oversee the human element of the InvenTrust Water Impact Challenges. InvenTrust will ensure that the utmost care is taken when judging participants and will establish appropriate guidelines for working with participants throughout these Challenges.

JUDGING PANEL

InvenTrust will recruit judges with expertise in water technology, business application design and development, and innovation. Judges will convene throughout the Challenges to collaborate, review guidelines, ask questions, and ensure that they are fully able to judge the challenge in a fair and appropriate manner.

COMPETITION INFORMATION WILL BE AVAILABLE IN THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS:

- **Terms and Conditions** — A document for registered participants that describes the final requirements and parameters of the competition and is binding on participants of the InvenTrust Water Impact Challenges.
- **Challenges Guidelines** – A document to guide participants through all stages of the Challenges to ensure clarity in understanding and smooth participation. The Guidelines describe the high-level requirements, implementation plans, and rules of the Phases of the InvenTrust Water Impact Challenges.
